

Installation for PalmOS devices

Please read the installation instructions carefully before use.

This version contains:

- the Scientific Programme and the Poster Abstracts
- links from the session, posters and exhibitors to the floor plans
- a listing of the exhibitors
- the floor plans of the congress center

Features:

- Scientific sessions and lectures by category
- Scientific sessions and lectures by time
- Oral, Poster and Speaker Abstract titles
- Plan of the congress centre
- Link from session and posters to the location (room, exhibition hall)
- Insert sessions into calendar (with alarm function)
- Show activities in a particular room
- Exhibition information, including floor plan of booths
- Free text search function
- Additional information about the congress and the city

Palm installation requirements:

- A PalmOS PDA running PalmOS Version 3.5 or higher.
- At least 1 MB of free memory space
- A Windows PC with the Palm Desktop software and the Palm Hotsync Manager installed. You find more information on the Palm Desktop software and the Hotsync Manager in the PalmOS PDA handbook.

Installation steps:

- Unpack the ZIP file into a directory of your choice.
- Check whether you have enough free memory space on your Palm (at least 1 MByte).*
- Put your PDA into the cradle and make sure that it is connected to the PC.
- Start the "Palm Desktop" application and open the "Quick Install" Tool.
- Using the install tool select the Palm (the HotSync ID) you wish to install the program to.
- Add the "eular09Base.prc" and "eular09Data.prc" files to the list of applications to be installed.
- Close the "Quick Install" Tool.
- Perform a Hotsync. This may take longer as usual because the application is transferred to the handheld.

- Locate the "eular09" application by means of the Palm Application Launcher and launch it. The application database is now extracted into the main memory. This may take a while.

- If you have a memory card installed in your PDA, you will be asked to put the application database to the memory card. With the database installed on a memory card, the application only needs about 200 KBytes of free memory to run.

* To know how much memory is available on your Palm PDA, tap the "house" icon to display the main Palm screen. Tap the "menu" icon, then choose "Info" from the "App" menu. You will see your free memory and total memory listed at the top of the "Info" box.
