

Installation for Windows mobile / Pocket PC based handhelds

Please read the installation instructions carefully before use.

This version contains:

- the Scientific Programme and the Poster Abstracts
- links from the session, posters and exhibitors to the floor plans
- a listing of the exhibitors
- the floor plans of the congress center

Features:

- Scientific sessions and lectures by category
- Scientific sessions and lectures by time
- Oral, Poster and Speaker Abstract titles
- Plan of the congress centre
- Link from session and posters to the location (room, exhibition hall)
- Insert sessions into calendar (with alarm function)
- Show activities in a particular room
- Exhibition information, including floor plan of booths
- Free text search function
- Additional information about the congress and the city

Pocket PC installation requirements:

- a Windows mobile / Pocket PC based handheld or smartphone running Windows CE Version 3.0 or higher and at least 4 MB of free memory space*
- Windows 98, ME, 2000, XP: PC with Microsofts ActiveSync program installed. You find information on ActiveSync in the Pocket PC handbook.
- Windows Vista: PC with "Windows Mobile Device Center" installed. You find the mobile Device Center in the Control Panel. If the Mobile Device Center was not installed on your system, you may download it from <http://www.microsoft.com/windowsmobile/devicecenter.msp>

Installation steps:

- Unpack the ZIP file into a directory of your choice.
- Check whether you have enough free memory space on your Pocket PC (at least 4 MB).*
- Put your Pocket PC into your cradle and make sure that it is connect to the PC via ActiveSync.
- Using Windows Explorer find the .exe file that you downloaded to your PC.
- Doubleclick the "Setup_eular2009_small.exe". This will install the application to your Pocket PC handheld.
- To finish the installation, follow the instructions on the screen of your Pocket PC handheld.
- Locate the "EULAR 2009" application either via the item "Programs" or directly from the "Start" menu of your device.

* To know how much memory is available on your Pocket PC device, select "Settings" from the Start menu. Tap the "System" tab, then tap on the "Memory" icon. You will see your free memory behind the label "Free:".
