

## SUPPORTING MEMBERSHIP OF EULAR APPLICATION AS SCIENTIFIC AFFILIATE

Scientific societies that cannot become Ordinary Members of EULAR, can apply for the Supporting Membership category (Art. 2.3 Statutes) as Scientific Affiliates. Scientific Affiliates are scientific societies that are not Ordinary Members of EULAR (Art 2.3.2 Statutes). A scientific society active in the field of rheumatology, that wishes to become a Supporting Member of EULAR must send its application to the EULAR Board. The Board decides upon the admission as Supporting Member.

Each Supporting Member has the right to participate at the EULAR General Assembly with one delegate (Art 4.2.1 Statutes). It has no right to vote.
